1. *May 27, Reuters* – (Minnesota) **ONEOK Minnesota natgas line remains shut after explosion-sheriff.** ONEOK Inc.'s Viking Gas Transmission natural gas pipeline in Marshall County, Minnesota, remained closed May 27 after exploding May 26, prompting the closure of the line, and causing two towns to remain without gas until May 28. Authorities were investigating the incident after spending 2 hours extinguishing the fire.

Diesel generators activated when power was lost, and preliminary indications showed that the power outage originated in the plant's switch yard.

- 6. *May 23, IDG News Service* (International) **Researchers find large global botnet of infected PoS systems.** IntelCrawler researchers discovered a botnet known as Nemanja that has infected around 1,500 point-of-sale (PoS) terminals, accounting systems, and other retail systems in the U.S. and several other countries. The malware behind the botnet is able to collect payment card information and contains a keylogger to obtain other information entered into infected systems.

- 12. *May 24, Food Safety News* (Texas) **Outbreak Salmonella strain closes Texas restaurant.** Fuego Tortilla Grill in College Station reopened May 24 after it voluntarily closed for 12 hours to undergo a deep cleaning due to reports from the Brazos County Health Department that the restaurant was likely the source of a Salmonella Typhimurium outbreak that has resulted in 30 confirmed cases since September 2013. The Illinois Department of Agriculture announced May 23 that a judge ordered Art's Tamales in Metamora to close May 21 after the company failed to correct unsanitary food-handling conditions found during inspections since 2013.

14. *May 23, U.S. Food and Drug Administration* – (Illinois) **Belleville Farmer's Market recalls Shelled Walnuts because of possible health risk.** Belleville Farmer's Market recalled 8-ounce containers of Farmer's Market-branded Shelled Walnuts that were packaged between March and May and distributed to its Belleville, Illinois retail stores due to possible Listeria monocytogenes contamination. The recall was initiated after U.S. Food and Drug Administration sampling revealed Listeria monocytogenes in walnuts from a supplier.

15. May 23, U.S. Food and Drug Administration – (Kansas; California) Sun Tree LLC recalls 12oz packaged California Grown Shelled Walnuts due to possible health risk. Sun Tree LLC voluntarily recalled 46 cases of 24 count 12-ounce produce bags of California Grown Shelled Walnuts due to possible Listeria monocytogenes contamination. The recall was initiated after sampling by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration detected Listeria monocytogenes in walnuts from California-based Golden State Foods, which supplied the walnuts that were packaged by Sun Tree for retail in Kansas City, Kansas.

- 16. May 23, U.S. Food and Drug Administration (National) Brunkow Cheese issues allergy alert on undeclared soy in Jalapeno Pepper Raw Milk Cheddar Cold Pack Cheese. The U.S. Food and Drug Administration announced May 23 that Brunkow Cheese voluntarily recalled 8-ounce containers of its Fayette Creamery branded Jalapeno Pepper Raw Milk Cheddar Cold Pack Cheese Spread due to undeclared soy. - 17. *May 22, Omaha World-Herald* (Nebraska) **14 cattle killed, 10 injured after train, cattle truck collide.** A Union Pacific passenger train collided with a semi-truck carrying cattle near Maxwell May 22, killing 14 cattle and injuring 10 others. The tracks at the railroad crossing just north of U.S. Highway 30 were closed for about 2 hours while crews cleaned the debris from scene.

Whole Foods Market issued a recall for 9-ounce containers of its Whole Foods Market Kitchens salad, labeled as Whole Foods Market Thai Soba Noodle Salad under the Health Starts Here category, due to undeclared soy. The product was sold in Whole Foods Market stores across five States.

The hospital reported that the computers contained an archive of documents housed on its local drive as well as 20 emails which included patients' information.

The gunman shot two people at a sorority house before driving around targeting others in the area while officers were pursuing his vehicle, which eventually crashed, with investigators finding the suspect dead with a gunshot wound to the head.

WordPress stated that a fix for the vulnerability would be included in an upcoming update.
