1. *November 15, KCAU 9 Sioux City* – (Iowa) **Gas leak shuts down 6-8 block area in Estherville.** Up to an 8-block area of Estherville, Iowa, was shutdown overnight November 15 – November 16 while Black Hills Energy crews worked to repair a 4-inch natural gas line that was cut by a drilling crew November 15. One area home was evacuated, and the Demoney Elementary School and gym at Iowa Lakes Community College were also evacuated as a precaution.

2. *November 15, TheCarConnection.com* – (National) **2004-2008 Mazda RX-8 recalled for fire risk: nearly 70,000 U.S. vehicles affected.** Mazda Motor Corporation issued a recall November 15 for 69,477 of its model years 2004 – 2008 Mazda RX-8 vehicles sold in the U.S. due to an issue with the fuel pump's sealing rings, which can deteriorate over time when exposed to high temperatures and cause the pumps to leak fuel, thereby creating a fire hazard. Mazda has confirmed seven incidences of the sealing rings failing.

3. *November 15, KOTV 6 Tulsa* – (Oklahoma) **Former Tulsa attorney pleads guilty to embezzling almost \$600K.** A disbarred Tulsa County, Oklahoma attorney pleaded guilty November 15 after he embezzled \$587,000 from probate estate accounts at the Bank of Oklahoma from August 2012 – October 2015 by illegally using checks made out to himself, diverting funds from the probate estates, and depositing the checks into his business and personal accounts to use for personal expenses.

4. *November 15, Huntington Patch* – (National) **2 Long Island men among trio charged**

in \$5M investment scam: DA. Three men were indicted November 15 for their alleged involvement in a more than \$5 million investment scam where the trio persuaded investors to funnel funds into a new social media platform they created that was purportedly sponsored by Staples, Inc. and Myspace.com. The charges allege that the trio used the proceeds to cover personal expenses and the supposed business relationship with Staples and Myspace could not be verified.

5. *November 16, WFTV 9 Orlando* – (Florida) **CSX works to clear rail cars from tracks after 2-train derailment in Citra.** A CSX Transportation spokesperson reported that 2 of its freight trains collided in the Citra area of Marion County, Florida, November 15, causing multiple rail cars to derail and spilling diesel fuel. Officials were assessing the situation and working to determine the cause of the collision and the number of cars that derailed.

6. *November 16, KNIA 1320 AM Knoxville/KRLS 92.1 FM Pella* – (Iowa) **Name released of person killed in rollover crash on Highway 163.** Highway 163 in Marion County, Iowa, was closed for 3 hours November 15 following a single-vehicle rollover crash that killed 1 person and injured 2 others.

7. *November 16, KTLA 5 Los Angeles* – (California) **Overturned big rig temporarily blocks 5 Freeway in Santa Clarita; driver suspected of DUI.** Two lanes of the southbound 5 Freeway in Santa Clarita, California, were closed for several hours November 15 – November 16 after a semi-truck overturned and spilled its load on the roadway. The driver suffered minor injuries.

9. *November 15, WBTS 8 Boston* – (Massachusetts) **MBTA: 2 hurt in crash between Silver Line bus and vehicle in Boston.** Officials are investigating the cause of a collision involving a Massachusetts Bay Transportation Authority (MBTA) Silver Line bus and another vehicle at the intersection of William E. Mullins Way and Washington Street in Boston November 15. Two passengers were sent to an area hospital with

injuries.

11. *November 15, U.S. Food and Drug Administration* – (National) **4C Foods Corp. voluntarily recalls 4C Grated Cheese, Homestyle Grated Cheese, and Cento Grated Cheese Brands net wt. 6 oz glass jars because of possible health risk.** 4C Foods Corp. issued a voluntary recall November 15 for its 4C Grated Cheese, Homestyle Grated Cheese, and Cento Grated Cheese Brand products sold in 6-ounce jars after Federal testing revealed the products had the potential to be contaminated with Salmonella. 12. *November 15, U.S. Department of Agriculture* – (California) **Piccadilly Fine Foods recalls Beef Shepherd's Pie due to misbranding and undeclared allergens.** Piccadilly Fine Foods issued a recall November 15 for roughly 144 pounds of its "Beef Shepherd's Pie with Vegetables, Made with Beef Chuck Steak" products sold in 8-ounce packages due to mislabeling and undeclared anchovies after Federal inspectors discovered that the product label failed to declare that the products were made with Worcestershire sauce that contains anchovies. No illnesses or adverse reactions have been reported and the products were shipped to retail establishments in California. 14. *November 16, WGCL 46 Atlanta* – (Georgia) **Rough Ridge fire burns more than 23,000 acres.** More than 200 fire crews reached 30 percent containment November 15 of the Rough Ridge Fire, which has burned through over 23,000 acres in the Cohutta Wilderness within the Chattahoochee National Forest in Fannin County, Georgia. Officials reported that a lightning strike sparked the fire.

15. *November 15, Middletown Times Herald-Record* – (New York) **Wildfire burns 440 acres in Harriman State Park.** About 50 New York State Department of Environmental Conservation personnel reached 90 percent containment November 15 of a 440-acre wildfire burning on the Orange County side of Harriman State Park. Crews also reached full containment of the 100-acre Pine Meadow Fire burning on the Rockland County side of the State park.

16. *November 15, Associated Press* – (New Hampshire) **Brush fire in national forest 50 percent contained.** Crews reached 50 percent containment November 15 of a 327-acre fire burning in the White Mountain National Forest in New Hampshire. No structures are threatened or have been lost as a result of the fire.

17. *November 15, WKRN 2 Nashville* – (Tennessee) **More than 60 wildfires still burn in Tennessee; arson suspected in nearly half.** Tennessee officials reported November 15 that code orange air quality alerts remain in effect for several regions across the State due to poor air quality stemming from 67 wildfires that have burned a total of 15,914 acres. The Tennessee Department of Health stated that more than 200 residents in Chattanooga have been hospitalized due to breathing difficulties related to the fires.

18. *November 15, WPIX 11 New York* – (New Jersey) **School bus driver killed after fiery head-on collision with van in Colts Neck, NJ.** A school bus driver was killed and a student was transported to the hospital November 15 after a vehicle traveling eastbound on Phalanx Road in Colts Neck, New Jersey, struck the school bus head-on, causing the bus to catch fire. The collision remains under investigation.

Five people including three students were injured.

20. *November 16, SecurityWeek* – (International) **Symantec patches DLL hijacking flaw in enterprise products.** Symantec released updates to resolve a dynamic-link library (DLL) flaw affecting its IT Management Suite (ITMS) 8.0, Ghost Solution Suite (GSS) 3.1, and Endpoint Virtualization (SEV) 7.x products, which could cause a rogue DLL file to be loaded by the software before the legitimate file, leading to arbitrary code execution, potentially with elevated privileges, as the affected products do not use an absolute path when loading DLL files during reboot or boot-up.

21. *November 16, SecurityWeek* – (International) **Serious flaws found in Lynxpring SCADA product.** The Industrial Control Systems Cyber Emergency Response Team (ICS-CERT) published an advisory that revealed versions 1.1.8 and earlier of Lynxpring's JENEsys building operating system, the BAS Bridge, is affected by four remotely-exploitable vulnerabilities after a security researcher discovered a flaw that could allow an attacker with read-only access to send maliciously crafted commands to the application and make changes within the app. The researcher also found a flaw that can be exploited to access a system without authentication by using a hardcoded username with no password, as well as a cross-site request forgery (CSRF) vulnerability that could allow an attacker to carry out various malicious actions if they convince a user into accessing a maliciously crafted link, among other flaws.

22. *November 15, SecurityWeek* – (International) **Shazam for Mac keeps listening even when disabled.** Synack security researchers reported that malware could silently spy on Apple Mac OS X users through the device's Webcam and microphone by piggybacking on legitimate applications that utilize those components, such as the Shazam music discovery app, FaceTime, and Skype after finding that the Mac version of Shazam does not deactivate the device's microphone once the user switches off the app. The researcher warned malware could leverage this flaw to capture audio from a device's microphone without initiating a recording.
